We will meet at the La Tuna Canyon/Hostetter Fire Road intersection (Crescenta Valley-La Tuna Canyon Road at 210 Freeway).

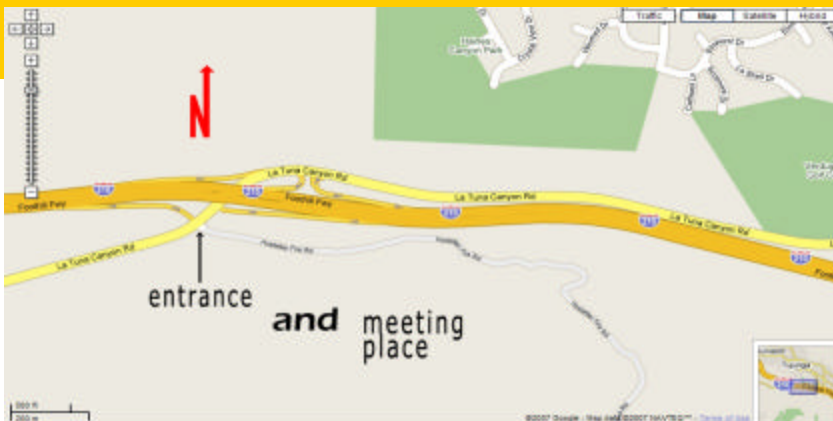
Gate closes at 9:15 a.m., so please be prompt. The event will conclude by 1:00 p.m. and the gate will be reopened at 1:15 p.m.
