

At the June 18, 2008 Community meeting for the Lopez Canyon Restoration Project, members and stakeholders of the Foothill Trails District Neighborhood Council were informed by Khalil Gharios from the Bureau of Sanitation and by Deputy John de la Rosa from Councilman Alarcon's office about the Truck Driving Academy to be placed on top of the Lopez Canyon Landfill.

We are requesting copies of the following:

- Any and all applications and Conditional Use Permit for the proposed Truck Driving Academy at Lopez Canyon
- Zoning Compliance and/or Land Use changes
- Memorandum of Agreement between the Teamsters Joint Counsel 42 Training Academy, Inc. and the Bureau of Sanitation
- The Lake View Terrace/Pacoima Community Advisory Committee postings and all minutes of all meetings and names of members.

How does the proposed Truck Driving Academy comply with the General Plan? Have any environmental reviews been completed? How does the proposed Truck Driving Academy comply with CEQA?

We want to know if the City Attorney has made a finding that the proposed Truck Driving Academy complies with the closing agreement approved by the Los Angeles City Council.

We oppose this project. It will have a negative impact on the surrounding communities due to increased noise, air pollution, and traffic. The Truck Driving Academy should not move forward.
