Dear Mr. Weintraub,

The Foothill Trails District Neighborhood Council, at its General Board meeting this evening, voted to request that the Planning Department require Angeles Golf Course to comply with its original condition 10 to transfer approximately 200 acres of Habitat Preservation Land to the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy as was proposed and intended to be made at the time of issuing the Certificate of Occupancy. It is further requested that Angeles National Golf Course finish the negotiations as to maintenance of the land with the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy. The community relied on this being accomplished and now there isn't the same incentive for the Golf Course to comply and we request Planning and the City's pressure to make them follow through with this condition as well as Condition 25 which addresses the construction and maintenance of trails. In additional we are in SUPPORT of the Appeal as presented by the California Department of Fish and Game.

We also request that the City inform us of what measures it takes regarding these matters.
