Dear Associate Zoning Administrator Wyatt

This evening, the Foothill Trails District Neighborhood Council, at its General Board Meeting, voted to SUPPORT your DETERMINATION of compliance for ZA 2000-4597(CU)-A1 for the continued use, operation and maintenance of a horse boarding facility, in conjunction with an existing single-family home in the A2-1K- Zone at 9753 La Tuna Canyon Road in Sun Valley.

The Land Use Committee has been soliciting information from the community regarding this facility for a number of months. Responses of Committee members from the La Tuna Canyon area and from residents at the La Tuna Canyon Community Association meetings have been nothing but positive for what is considered a state of the art facility. The appeal presented was a surprise to many. Enclosed is a petition signed by 28 neighbors who support the Equestrian center. Additional support was heard in FTDNC meetings as well. There seems to be some concern as to the accuracy of facts as presented in the appeal as well as why the appellant is acting as a representative of those neighbors he listed, rather than having their signatures as authentication.

Additional conversations with the facility indicate their willingness to work with the neighborhood regarding any problems in a reasonable and respectful manner.
