The special general meeting on July 28, 2026 covered several major community, public-safety, land-use, and administrative issues. The council also took formal action after establishing a quorum.

- The council has vacated its Shadow Hills office because of liability and parking-lot issues. Equipment was moved into a pod being hosted by All Nations Church without rent at the time of the meeting.
- Officer Wil Godoy reported 175 crimes year-to-date versus 200 at the comparable point the prior year. Discussion focused on speeding, equestrian safety, limited police resources, ATVs, illegal dumping, and the possibility of pursuing funding for an ATV/4x4 capability.
- A substantial discussion concerned a proposed CUP for 10420 Kurt Street. The owner proposed horse boarding, an eventual equestrian therapeutic program, and up to 48 events annually to help generate funding for a planned charity. Participants were generally receptive to horse boarding and therapeutic equestrian uses but expressed strong opposition to an event venue because of noise, traffic, parking, and the residential setting. The applicants agreed to reconsider the proposal and return before submitting an application.

Council Business

The council approved increasing funding for an event from \$1,000 to \$1,600, with two abstentions recorded in the roll-call vote. Pamela Miller was also unanimously appointed to fill the remaining open board seat after a corrected roll-call vote.

Administrative updates included new annual funding-training requirements, preparations for the May 1, 2027 Neighborhood Council election, committee reports, National Night Out planning, and concerns about ensuring future meeting information provides the correct Zoom access details.
