

March 2026 General Meeting Minutes

No quorum was present. Informational meeting only.

The Foothill Trails Neighborhood Council met on March 24, 2026, but never reached quorum, so no formal board votes were taken. The meeting instead focused on community reports, public safety, finances, outreach, and equestrian issues.

- Officer Wil Godoy reported 26 crimes in January and 24 in February, 18 fewer combined than the comparable period the previous year. Discussion also covered homelessness near Lake View Terrace Park, the importance of reporting suspected crimes, and preparations for large upcoming events at Hansen Dam.
- The council reported \$43,278 in total funding for the fiscal year and approximately \$13,009 spent so far, with discussion emphasizing completing purchases by around Memorial Day because future rollover funding was uncertain. Outreach proposals included branded community giveaways and expanded use of Nextdoor.
- The Equestrian Committee discussed protecting and maintaining local bridle paths, including a reportedly unpermitted fence at Wheatland and Foothill blocking a recognized trail, trail mapping and survey work, horse-safety signage, and damaged infrastructure. Members also explored funding replacement signage at Hansen Dam by purchasing materials while relying on city staff for production or installation.

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
