The January 27, 2026 Neighborhood Council meeting focused heavily on the long-delayed 210 Freeway sound wall and a proposed expansion at Village Christian School. The board established quorum and reappointed former board member Alisa Clare to the final open seat.

- Metro representatives said the Lake View Terrace sound wall is on the unfunded Phase 2 list, which contains roughly 69 miles of proposed walls costing more than \$1 billion overall. Metro recently approved \$1.5 million for an initial study of an approximately one-mile Lake View Terrace segment, but representatives could provide no construction date because funding has not been identified. Residents pressed Metro about decades of delays and were encouraged to pursue funding opportunities with elected officials and other agencies.
- Village Christian School presented plans for a new gymnasium, renovations and a second-story addition to an existing building. The school said the project would not increase enrollment, although residents raised significant concerns about existing traffic and temporary construction impacts. The proposal remains under city environmental review and will later require a hearing for its conditional use permit.
- The board approved November and December expense reports and related financial items, including up to \$750 for Verizon internet service. It also approved an Equestrian Committee letter concerning equine licensing and up to \$2,000 for a community shredding event. In a brief special meeting, the board additionally approved \$280 to pay for previously produced flyers.
