

December 2025 General Meeting Minutes

No quorum was present. Informational meeting only.

The Foothill Trails Neighborhood Council gathering on December 16, 2025 never achieved quorum, so the board could not vote on actionable items, including its outstanding monthly expenditure reports. Discussion proceeded only on reports and non-actionable matters.

- Public safety centered on declining crime, the absence of RVs and tents in the area, and persistent traffic, ATV, motorcycle, and speeding problems. Officer Godoy said requests for additional traffic-enforcement funding had not produced funding and that a requested 4x4 vehicle for wash patrols also remained unresolved.
- The council reported \$9,257.95 spent or committed and an additional \$18,000 approved for its budget. Members also began planning a community document-shredding event for spring, with an estimated cost of about \$1,000 and All Nations Church discussed as a possible venue.
- The president outlined anticipated 2026 meeting changes under SB707, including greater flexibility for remote participation, stricter agenda-posting requirements, and requirements affecting hybrid-meeting connectivity. Committees were advised to prepare agendas early enough to meet posting deadlines.

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
