The Foothill Trails Neighborhood Council met on November 25, 2025, with quorum established. The meeting focused on board membership, the long-running freeway sound-wall issue, traffic safety, infrastructure, and council finances.

- Member Lisa Baca resigned her seat so she could focus more on equestrian work.
- Former board member Judy Trujillo was unanimously appointed to a vacant board seat. An Assembly representative discussed state budget constraints and the Lake View Terrace sound wall, expressing concern about Metro's ability to complete the project promptly. Metro was scheduled to attend the council's December meeting.
- Traffic safety dominated public discussion. City representatives described studies and proposed improvements for Sunland Boulevard, Wentworth, and La Tuna Canyon, including replacing missing or faded signs, reviewing signal timing, exploring speed cameras, improving lighting, and considering other roadway changes. Residents emphasized recurring crashes and speeding on Sunland Boulevard.
- The council adopted the October 2025 monthly expense report with two abstentions. The treasurer reported roughly \$24,000 remaining before outstanding office-rent deductions. The board also decided to hold a December meeting rather than go dark, in part because Metro was expected to attend.
