The Foothill Trails Neighborhood Council met on September 23, 2025. Discussion centered on illegal dumping, equestrian and park issues, Whiteman Airport, public safety, city policy developments, and council finances.

- Government representatives discussed cleanup of chronic illegal-dumping locations, proposed state legislation, the city's avoidance of civil-service layoffs, and efforts to accelerate LAPD hiring. Members also raised concerns about proposed charter-reform ideas involving housing development on city-owned park land, particularly possible effects on equestrian areas.
- Equestrian updates included concerns about the deteriorated arena at Hansen Dam, damaged guardrails and fencing along horse trails, missing or vandalized vehicle-restriction signs, and difficulties disposing of horse manure. Public Safety continued work on wildfire and evacuation preparedness.
- A lengthy Whiteman Airport update described a county-commissioned study examining redevelopment versus closure. The discussion highlighted federal grant obligations, FAA approval requirements, land purchased with federal funding, and the consultants' reported finding that redevelopment may be easier than closure. The board also approved the July and August monthly expenditure reports by roll-call vote.
